Rapid Response Deforestation Monitoring Fellow

WHO WE ARE: Mighty Earth is a global environmental advocacy organization focused on driving private sector ambition to tackle urgent environmental issues, particularly in the food/agricultural sector. Chaired by former representative and environmental champion Henry Waxman, our campaigns drive industry reforms at the nexus of environment and public health, and have persuaded the world's largest food and agriculture companies to adopt policies to eliminate deforestation and human rights abuses from their supply chains.

WHAT WE NEED: Mighty Earth is piloting and launching a rapid-response deforestation monitoring system, that aims to spur private sector action to respond to deforestation alerts. We need a savvy and passionate Fellow to oversee the pilot project and help get it up to scale, starting in January and working part time approximately 10-15 hours/week.

RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE: Key elements of this position include

- Analyzing satellite imagery to detect palm-oil driven deforestation in Southeast Asia
- Creating compelling narratives using satellite data on deforestation to spur action
- Coordinating workflows and communication between our remote sensing team, Campaign Directors, and on-the-ground field teams to collect and synthesize deforestation alerts and supply-chain data
- Collecting, compiling, and distributing information on deforestation to relevant stakeholders, and managing responses.

QUALIFICATIONS INCLUDE: The ideal candidate will have

- A strong passion for protecting forests
- Demonstrated experience coordinating communication between multiple teams
- Ability to work independently in a fast-paced environment
- Experience working with satellite imagery from various sources
- Strong written communication skills, particularly in a persuasive advocacy style.
